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1. Disqualification grounds of bankruptcy, making an arrangement with creditors, conviction of any indictable offence, conviction of offence involving fraud or dishonesty, being the subject of an order under sections 838, 842 and 850 of the Companies Act 2014, or being sentenced to a term of imprisonment.
 2. Disqualification on grounds of membership (or of being a nominee) of either House of the Oireachtas or of the European Parliament, or of being an employee of the Pharmaceutical Society of Ireland.
 3. To be eligible to be placed on a panel in the event that an election occurs, the candidate will meet the criteria outlined in Rule 14 of the PSI (Council) Rules 2008 and 2015.
